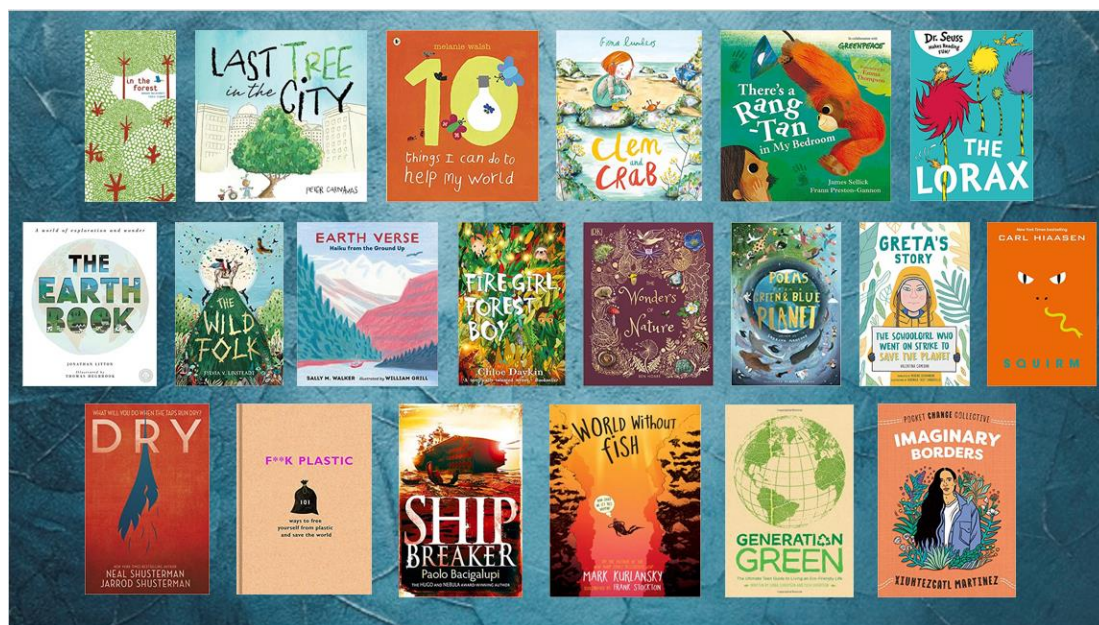


Climate Change Booklist for children and young people
