INTRODUCTION

A **laugh-out-loud** book with cake and penguins. The question is, did those naughty penguins really eat the cake or was it Albert all along? Follow their **madcap adventures** around the world.

This is the only shortlisted book that has an author *and* an illustrator working together to create the story. Look closely at the illustrations to spot all the extra details that the illustrator has added to the text.

ACTIVITIES

Read: What can your child or children find out about real-life penguins? How many species (or kinds) of penguins are there? Where in the world do they live? How tall is the tallest penguin? Look out for the real-life story of *Emperor of the Ice* by Nicola Davies & Catherine Rayner (Walker, 2023).
