# THE FASTEST TORTOISE IN TOWN

## INTRODUCTION

An amusing reworking of the **traditional story** about *The Hare and the Tortoise*. Told from the point of view of a **pet tortoise** called Barbara Hendricks, whose owner has entered her into a race against other animals. In spite of the tortoise's self-doubt, her owner Lorraine, puts her on a training programme. Unbeknown to the tortoise, her competitors are not the fastest of **animals** themselves, but she determinedly forges ahead and wins the race! With renewed confidence, Barbara Hendricks happily accepts the hare's challenge to race ... Can your child or children predict what might happen?

## ACTIVITIES

**Read** a version of the original story about the tortoise and the hare. Explore other fables by Aesop and talk about some of the moral lessons of the stories. For example: 'slow and steady wins the race'.

Write and illustrate Watch the film about Leopard Tortoises (in the Links) and make a list of key words to find definitions for (such as reptile, herbivore, habitat, solitary, predators, diurnal). Either independently <u>or</u> collaboratively write a short, illustrated information text about Leopard Tortoises living in the wild.

**Create** a paper tortoise by following these simple instructions: <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=miai5u8D6nM</u> This is a simple craft activity suitable for book clubs/groups. In school, the tortoises could be included in a table-top or wall display.
