GROTTI

Younger Children Shortlist 2025

INTRODUCTION

Narrated by a **knight**, this is the story of how he finds a sweet **baby monster** who is lost. The knight does a good job of looking after him, swapping his own possessions for items required to keep Grotti comfortable, warm and well fed. But after a while, Grotti becomes homesick and the **kind** knight helps him to find his way back to his **family**. This means that the knight can now return to what he would normally be doing (battling dragons and defending kingdoms) – but then he realises that something is missing, 'something green and something grotti'. An engaging story about the sacrifices involved in parenting and the **love** that can grow between carer and cared-for.

When sharing the book encourage your child/children to take time to look at the detail in the pictures. Can they work out what's wrong with Grotti before the knight does? Or spot what the knight uses instead of the pieces of armour he has swapped.

ACTIVITIES

Read a retelling of the traditional story of Saint George. St George's Day takes place on 23rd April. Find out how the day is celebrated by watching the films in the Links section.

Write and illustrate a story map which shows the different creatures the knight and Grotti meet along the way. The eleventh double page spread of the book provides a useful visual summary.

Create a simple cardboard shield and sword and/or a dragon's mask using this template https://mrprintables.com/dragon-masks.html Use them to act out the story of Saint George.
